World Changers – In case you are not aware of it, World Changers is now an independently owned non-profit organization. When LifeWay made the decision last May to discontinue this program, a group of experienced coordinators did not want to see such an impactful ministry end. So, they worked together to secure the rights from LifeWay to continue the World Changers name and operation. Therefore, while it has the same goals of equipping students for a lifetime of missional living and knowing how to share the story of Jesus with others, it is now under a new group of leaders. And, the Manager of World Changers is our own David Flatt, who is on staff at FBC Panama City, as Associate Pastor/Adult Education. World Changers has several projects scheduled for this coming summer, ranging from five to seven days in length and in 13 different states. One of these projects will be held here in our own area.
